### What is the "Data Blitz" and how do I participate?

The Data Blitz will comprise 4-5 very short presentations (5 slides, 10 minutes) of work by students or post-docs. Each presentation will be followed by a 10 minute discussion. The goal is to showcase new work from young BRAMS researchers. This will give everyone the opportunity to hear about the new and exciting projects going on within BRAMS, and give the students the opportunity to get feedback from their colleagues. Students & post-doc. interested in participating in the data blitz should contact their BRAMS supervisor.

In order to select the talks, we are requesting that each member submit a proposal for one presentation. The proposal should be a one-page abstract that emphasizes the interest and novelty of the findings. The proposals will be reviewed and talks selected based on quality and offering a broad range of topics.
